What is an art medium?

- An art medium is the material being used to make art.
- Art may be made by using one material, or medium, or it may use a variety of materials, or media.

 A good way to see what media you like to use is to explore different materials and ways to use them.








What is an art technique?

- An art technique is "any method of working with art materials to produce an art object." (ArtLex)
- Techniques are how we use the materials. Some examples may be:
 - Hatching
 - Brushing
 - Washing
 - Stippling







What is a concentration?

- A concentration is a body of related works that demonstrate a sustained and thoughtful investigation of a specific visual idea.
- This may be as simple as cup:
